## M1 GARAND CLASS

### May 9<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, & 13<sup>th</sup> 2017

WWCCA will host an M1 Garand Class designed to introduce New Shooters to the fundamentals of position shooting with this classic firearm. The course is sanctioned by the CMP and will be instructed by Frank Sinagra, CMP Master Instructor, and Mike Bailey, CMP Master Instructor.

This course will cover the safe handling and operation of the M1 Garand, hands-on instruction of the Standing and Prone positions, instruction on how to shoot a CMP Garand Match, and rifle accuracy techniques. Class instruction with dry-fire practice in each position, will be Tuesday and Thursday night from 7:00 pm to 9:30 pm (5/9 and 5/11), in the WWCCA Clubhouse, followed by an actual live-fire CMP Garand 30-round Match shot on the Club's 100 yard range on Saturday May 13th from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm. During Saturday's match, Club Experts will coach each shooter safely and effectively through the course. You may bring your own Garand, or use one of the Club's Garands at no additional charge. By the conclusion of this course, beginner Shooters will have a clear understanding of position shooting and will be prepared to shoot a 2-position CMP Garand match.

**Cost is \$40** for this course. It includes CMP course materials, awards, 35 rounds of 30'06 or 5.56mmammunition, bottled water, and lunch.

Individuals interested in taking this class, but wishing to complete the course with an AR-15 style rifle may do so.

WWCCA has one AR-15 A-2 Rifle that will be available for one shooter on each of the three match relays. If you want to sign up for this rifle, please do so with your reservation; first come, first served.

If you have your own AR-15 rifle and wish to compete with it, you may use it during the course as long as it is capable of utilizing a standard USGI web sling or 1907 style leather sling.

Scopes with magnification no greater than 4x will be permitted, however, we recommend using standard adjustable open sights.
