Rifle News

Results of the Summer League:

The next (Match #2) Winter League rifle match will be held Saturday, January 7th on the 100 Yard range. Relays will begin every hour from 10:00 until 1:00 (10:00, 11:00, 12:00 and 1:00). If you wish to shoot more than one match on the same day, you are welcome to do so. If you missed the first match last month, you will have ample opportunity to make it up either by shooting two matches on the same day, or by shooting at our "make up" match in May.

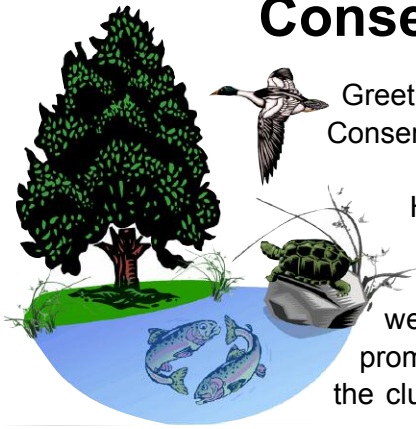

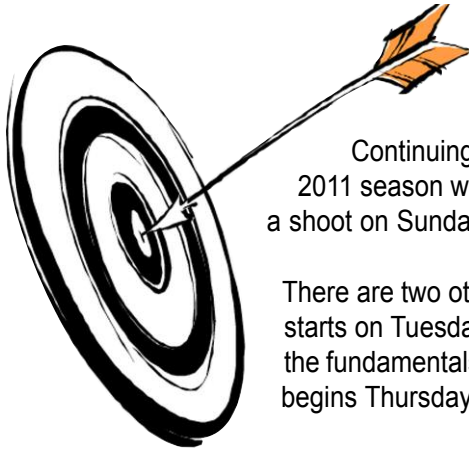
